Description

Six trenches were excavated, totalling 150 metres in length and all of these trenches lay within the footprint of proposed development. Only three of the trenches revealed any archaeology, with the majority of the features being concentrated in Trench 2. In total, 10 features were identified. Trenches 1 and 3 had three linears (all probably unrelated) whilst Trench 2 contained 6 pits all centred towards the eastern end of this trench. Archaeological evaluation on the site identified ten features in the form of linears and pits. As the archaeology is undated it is impossible to state with any certainty [given the site's position in relation to the known Medieval centre of Amberley] the possibility that the Medieval village contracted significantly and that this site is evidence of such a contraction in Medieval Amberley. {1}
